Reminder: What is INFLUENCERS about?

INFLUENCERS is a project funded by the Erasmus + programme. It officially started on the 1st of September 2019 and gathers 6 partners from Cyprus, France, Germany, Ireland, Poland and Portugal.

Under the supervision of the German coordinator, the consortium has developed:

- An online Social Entrepreneurship Curriculum that focuses on building knowledge, skills and competences necessary to support youth living with a disability or long-term health condition to develop next generation online social enterprises. (IO1)

- A curriculum of digital and social media literacy training resources targeting young people with a disability and/or long-term health condition. (IO2)

- An in-service training programme for youth workers, supporting them in the use of new online learning environments, revealing the potential of social online entrepreneurship for young people with a disability and/or long-term health condition, and explaining how to take important precautionary measures against the most common online threats (IO3)

- An e-learning portal as a one-stop-shop providing instant access to the full suite of learning resources developed. (IO4).

Latest news

Since the beginning of the project, the partners have developed the contents for the main project outcomes. However, the project end has been extended to the 28th of February 2022 to allow all partners to organise local tests in their countries, hoping that the Covid-19 crisis will be over in the next months.

The following results have been achieved:

Online Social Entrepreneurship Curriculum

The results of this curriculum have been finalised by Right Challenge (the leader of this Result) and the partners. They have translated the curriculum videos in Polish, Greek, French, German and Portuguese and the partners are now working on the translation of the modules. The final versions of the Curriculum in all the languages will be ready after summer and all partners will organise pilot tests in October with 10 youth living with a disability or a long-term health condition.





Digital & Social Media Literacy Curriculum

All the contents for the Digital and Social Media Literacy Curriculum have been developed and translated in the partners' languages. The related videos are also available in all the consortium's languages. A training for 10 youth living with a disability or a long-term health condition will also be organised to test this Curriculum.

In-Service Training Programme

A transnational training event was supposed to be held in Portugal in September involving 2 youth workers. However, because of the Covid-19 pandemic, the partners finally decided to organise the training online during the week from the 20th to the 24th of September. The partners will take into account the participants' feedback to the Programme and will organise local training with 8 additional youth workers in their countries.

E-learning Portal

The learning portal is almost ready in the partners' languages and will be functional for the online training in September.
